### Deputation:

The first month of 2022 has been a great month for our family as we have been able to go to many meetings as well as give the gospel out to many people. This month, we received an answer to one of our biggest prayer requests! The Lord has provided a company that will take care of EVERYTHING with regards to us moving to Uganda. Thank you to everyone who has been praying with us for this. This company is going to provide the shipping container, transporting it to the loading spot and then to the U.S. port, a cargo boat that will take it to the Kenyan port, and then a truck that will drive it from Kenya to our home in Uganda. This involves several companies as well as crossing several national borders. We are so thankful that they are coordinating all of it for us. On top of the blessing of their taking care of all the moving parts, their price was several thousand dollars cheaper than what we had budgeted for this part of our "start up." All the praise belongs to our gracious Lord who orchestrated this on our behalf.

The big prayer request now is for the Lord's protection to be on that container. Because the container will be traveling through multiple countries, each stop has the potential for the container to be stopped and searched. As we will not be able to be at these potential inspections, there is a risk of theft happening. Our entire life will be in this container including everything that we will need to start our ministry when we arrive in Uganda. Please pray that when the container arrives, it will still have everything in it. The other part of the protection prayer request is from the elements. The container gets very hot as it travels across the sea. There is also the chance of water getting into the container once it is offloaded. Please pray that there will be no damage to our items when the container arrives. We are thankful we serve such a big God! We know that He is "able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think." Thank you for your continued prayer support. One final prayer request we have is for wisdom on when to pack and send the container. Please pray that God will make it clear to us when the best time will be.
