Dear Pastors and Friends,

Deputation:

Praise the Lord for the great things that He has done! The Lord has kept us safe on the roads as we have gone from meeting to meeting. The Lord has allowed several more churches to partner with us as we finish up deputation. The Lord has been answering many of the prayers that we have asked you to pray for over these past few months.

A new prayer request that has come up is Jedidiah's health. We took him into his pediatrician at the end of this month for his standard nine month check-up. After the nurse did all of the preliminary items, the doctor came in and showed us that he hasn't gained any weight in the past month. He has been transitioning from milk and some solid foods to more solid foods, some milk, and some water. The doctor then recommended to us that we keep the solid foods, but transition back to only milk or formula. We decided that it would be best to switch to solid foods and formula. That day we made the switch and Jed hasn't been doing well since. We've talked with the doctor several times, and the consensus right now is that he caught a virus the same day that he switched to formula. Please pray for him that he will get better no matter what the issue is, and that he will start putting on weight. After all the blow-outs and spit-ups over the past seven days, he has become scared of drinking from a straw or a bottle. Please also pray that he will get over this fear.

We have three meetings left and then we will have completed our deputation! Thank you for your prayers, and thank you to all of our financial partners.
