Four men that work together at a business in Soroti were witnessed to several times as well as invited to church. Several of these men were Muslims and as a group, they continued to decline the gospel and the invitation to church. Eventually, one of these four men accepted Christ as his Savior. The one that received Christ then brought Oluka Daniel, one of the other three, to Sunday School. Immediately after Sunday School, Daniel walked up to me and asked if he can be saved! I then walked with him into a back room in the church and led him to the Lord. While Daniel was accepting Christ, the other two in the group walked into the morning service. After the morning service, these two accepted Christ as their Savior. One of the four was a Muslim man named Shareef. Shareef came to church the next week and anounced that he didn't want a Muslim name anymore so he changed his name to the Biblical name of Joseph. We rejoiced with these four men! The next Sunday, Joseph brought two of his cousins to church. Ali and Musa had seen a change in Joseph's life and wanted to see what it was all about. After that morning service, I was blessed to be able to lead both Ali and Musa to the Lord! Seeing the gospel spread through families and across religions shows the power of God and the power of His gospel! Praise be to God for the great things that He has done.

Please continue to be in prayer for our health. We also would like to ask you to keep praying for Jedidiah to be saved at an early age. Please be in prayer that Isaac, one of our security guards, will get saved. Finally, we need to hire a new security guard. Please pray that we will find a good one and that the hiring process will go quickly and smoothly.
